About the Lesson: "Twins That Weren't Alike"

First Part: Esau and Jacob were very different, weren't they? How were they different? How did Esau feel about the birthright? What did he do with it? What is our "birthright"? Could there be a "pot of lentils" in our lives that is more important to us than eternal life? (*Look up verses on activity sheet and fill in. Also share personal example from your life with the children.*)

Second Part: Jacob knew that God wanted him to be the inheritor of the promise made to Abraham. Did he trust God's power to bring about God's promise? What did he do instead? (*Give a practical example from your life of how you did/didn't let God give you the power to do what His Word says.*) How have we been like Jacob in trying to do the right thing in the wrong way? (*i.e. grit our teeth and obey, etc.*)

What does God give us so we don't have to clamor for our "pot of lentils"? (*Help children find 2 Samuel 22:33 and underline the promise.*) Today God offers us strength and power so we can choose to turn away from our "pottage" to perfect lives ready to receive our birthright of eternal life.

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
